Saline Rec Center to Enter Phase 2 of Their Reopening

Saline, MI – As of Monday October 12, 2020 the Saline Rec Center will be entering Phase 2 of their reopening plan.

Phase 2 will allow for day pass users to utilize the facility, open locker rooms and allow for basketball reservations.

Those who are not members of the Rec Center may begin using the facility on Monday by purchasing a day pass. Day pass users may use the pool or gym, but like members, they must reserve a time slot on the SignUpGenius. After they are finished using the facility, they must check out as a day pass user.

The locker rooms will be open but are limited to 10 people at a time. Those choosing to use the room are asked to maintain social distancing guidelines and wear masks at all times except while showering. Patrons are strongly encouraged to wipe their lockers with athletic disinfecting wipes provided before and after use. Staff will be entering the locker rooms several times a day for routine cleaning.

Half of the gym will be reopening for basketball reservations during certain times of the day. To use a basketball hoop, patrons must reserve a 1-hour time slot on SignUpGenius, the link can be found at cityofsaline.org/parks. Patrons will be limited to three signups per week and can only sign up for a spot to play by themselves or with members of the same household.
